Today's Noisy Offering for Tennyson Center for Children: Tennyson Center for Children has served Colorado's most neglected, abused, and traumatized children since 1904. They are known for their high standard of care across all programs and services. These services include an accredited, Therapeutic K-12 School and Day Treatment Program with a 4:1 student-to-staff ratio on campus and in-home and Community Programs in 18 counties across the state to provide preventive services and therapy to strengthen families with children aged 0 to adulthood. During the first half of FY21 (Oct 20 – Mar 21), 98% of families stayed together and 44% saw improved trauma symptoms across all Tennyson programs.

At Tennyson, the goal is to keep families strong and keep them together. An array of community services aims to do exactly that by creating access to therapy, skills building, and resource connection. Here in Colorado Springs, there is a Community Program based at First Christian Church with two therapists who work with families to provide these services. The Noisy Offering on September 11 will go to support these families in Colorado Springs. Please bring your loose change to put in the offering on Sunday or donate through the church website or app designating Tennyson Center as the recipient.
